TEACHING YOUR AUDIENCE THROUGH PERFORMANCE




An "informance" was a great way to start the year, especially in a community that does not have much choral background knowledge.

It was also a great way to have students show the community WHAT they have learned in choir *besides* the repertoire.

- We do more than just "sing songs"
- We know that... but does your community and administration know that?

If your choral program is smaller, great time filler as well!

STUDENT INTRODUCTIONS

- Students collaborate on what to say at the concert, as well as what they want to demonstrate at the informance
- Students audition for the speaking parts - this is a great way to practice the audition process before doing singing solo auditions
- Great assignment for sub days, and can tie into writing standards



OTHER IDEAS FOR AN INFORMANCE


- Honor Choir audition demonstration



PROJECT BASED LEARNING PERFORMANCE

Students sang in their choral ensemble, as well as in small groups.

These small groups acted as a "Project Based Learning" opportunity. Students selected from a choice of songs, and then worked on in it in small groups.

The idea is to present it as a "Public Product" - being "professional audiences".

Small groups performed in front of:

- Their peers
- Concert audience
- "Winterfest" Fundraiser Audience

- Collaboration between all 3 music disciplines
 - Invited HS performing groups as well
- Tried to use as a recruitment event as well - not as well received in terms of recruiting despite reaching out to all elementary feeders.
